



WAG COVID-19 Policy Arena November 2021

Note: Requirements may change as per provincial or federal restrictions.

A spot in a WAG class will be given once the student has:

- **read and agreed via email that they will follow this policy**
- **confirmed via email that they have been vaccinated, as per Ontario requirements.**

At the first class, students will be required to show that they meet Ontario requirements by showing proof that they have been fully vaccinated along with ID. If you are unable to do this, you will be unable to participate in class

Students may not come to class if:

- they have a fever
- they have been outside the country in the past 14 days
- they or anyone in their household have been in contact with a person known to have been infected with COVID-19 or to have any of the symptoms (fever, cough, etc) within the past 14 days

Students will be required to confirm that they meet the above requirements before accepting a spot in class. **We require that students ask themselves these questions before coming to each class.**

Anyone tested for COVID must advise their Instructor or the Head Instructor if they have tested positive.

Physical distancing, staying 2m apart, is to be maintained by all as per provincial regulations and signs posted. Masks are to be worn.



The waiting area will allow for room to ensure physical distancing. Marked areas “tie-downs” will be spaced accordingly. **They are not to be moved.** Each student is to remain with their dog at the “tie-down” unless otherwise instructed by their instructor. In order to ensure that physical distancing of 2m can be met, **we will not be allowing extra people (parents/partners/visitors) in the arena.**

Masks will be worn by everyone. If physical distancing permits, instructors may remove their mask to explain an exercise. Masks are not required when running a course.

Students are requested to provide hand sanitizer for themselves. However, WAG will make hand sanitizer available as a back-up.

WAG will have a porta potty available. You will need to provide your own wipes. **DO NOT put the sanitizing wipe in the porta potty.** Wipe and take it home!

Students not adhering to the policy will be warned by their instructor or the Head Instructor. If a second warning is required, the student will be asked to leave the class. Students in the class are encouraged to help remind their fellow students of the rules and to keep their physical distance.
